There has been lots going on in school over the last few weeks. 

THE CROSS BAY WALK SATURDAY 3RD MAY IS IN AID OF THE OLIVE BRANCH.

The Olive Branch is Lancaster's food bank, but we are so much more than a food bank. Our mission is to support those in Lancaster suffering distress caused by addiction, broken family relationships, poverty and homelessness, and to enable individuals and families to resolve and alleviate their difficulties. We do this by providing a multitude of resources be they physical, spiritual or emotional. To give this some context in 2024 (up to end of November) we were visited by guests 3,685 times, we gave out somewhere in the region of 125,000 food items, we have listened while people share their (often harrowing) situations, prayed with many guests, helped some guests get help from the police or social services, provided tents and sleeping bags to those living on the streets, provided uniform for primary school children and have accessed funds for guests to provide a whole range of items/support including clothes and taxi to attend a job interview, a laptop for a 6th form student, shoes for someone who had none and a portable heater for someone who had no working central heating. And this is just a snapshot of what we try to provide 5 days a week. Tickets for the walk are available to buy at https://the-olivebranch.org.uk/latest-news/cross-bay-walk-2025 and cost £20 per person (£2 for dogs). Walkers should be able to comfortably walk 9 miles. Our walk will start at 9.30am (registration no later than 9.15am) from Arnside Prom and should take approximately 4 hours, ending up at Grange over Sands. Michael Wilson, the King's Guide, will be in charge and take us all over the sands for what will be a magical day. We do hope you can join us for what we hope will be a fabulous day, but also one that will also raise vital funds for The Olive Branch.
