To message ring the Victoria Institute on 01524 771733 **Oak tree at the Fishstones** A tall, strong oak sapling has now been planted at the Fish Stones. Ted Curwen grew it from an acorn from the old tree. Planting this replacement was done by Chris Lennon with help from Ray Elvis. Chris has also improved the planting area and repaired and repainted the railings. Jamie Cottle has given the previous sapling a home at Borwicks, where it can be seen from the public footpath near Forge Mill. Thank you to them all!

**Fell View Play Park** The new toddler play hut has been installed, complete with slide and wobbly bridge. Our thanks to Lancaster Environmental Fund and Halton Hydro for helping fund this brilliant new kit for our Play Park. The replacement seating is due to be installed soon.

**Footpaths** A resident has walked all the footpaths in our parish and identified a wide range of problems, including missing signposts and waymarkers, damaged stiles and blocked paths. A councillor has prepared a full list of the issues, and will begin the work of liaising with landowners and Lancashire Public Rights of Way. It may take a while to get these improvements done. Our thanks to everyone who has helped with this.

**Barriers on A683 at Bull Beck** Lancashire Councty Council plans to erect permanent barriers before the end of the summer! Be good to have this safety feature installed at last.

**Greenway Enhancements** Foundations and paving for benches and picnic tables are now in place along the Greenway from Crook of Lune to Holme Lane. Work is also ongoing to manage stretches of hedging to open up views of the river and valley beyond. Thanks again to Lancashire Environmental Fund and to Lancashire County Council for funding this improvement scheme. Many thanks also to Georgina Peacock who donated her professional time to create the design and help manage the project.

**Local History Deposit Box** The Local History Deposit Box is at the Victoria Institute is now "live". To help anyone who might look at any deposits in the future there is handy form in the deposit box you might like to use. This has optional space for you describe/explain whatever is contributed. **Public toilet at the Victoria Institute** Apologies; the announcement of the new opening hours was premature as the Parish Council had not consulted all parties. If the extended opening happens, it will be after the Victoria Institute reopens after its rewiring.

White lines at the Hornby Road Car Park The Parish Council has accepted a price to repaint the white lines and repaint the yellow lines marking the disabled space.

**Closure of Brookhouse Road at Artlebeck Bridge** The dates for the road closure now look to be 27 May to 11 June, but the Parish Council has had no official notification from Lancashire Highways. As this will affect school buses during the exam season, there is pressure to get Cadent to defer the work until the school holidays. We are told the pedestrian bridge will remain open throughout. The Parish Clerk is speaking to Kirkby Lonsdale coaches to ensure they are aware of this road closure and to find out how they will continue to serve Brookhouse and Caton Green. Cadent has promised to send an inspector to work out how to keep other traffic moving.

**Footpath to Grays Seat** This is a concessionary path, rather than a public footpath. In Quernmore Parish, not ours. The landowner is unable to clear the fallen timber, but has said that local people are welcome to do so and to remove wood they can use. If you want to take advantage of this offer, please tell our Parish Clerk so she can inform Quernmore Parish Clerk who will liaise with the landowner.

Residents are welcome to attend and may speak about issues of local concern in the Open Forum at the start of every meeting.

#### PARISH COUNCIL CONTINUED

Once again residents are complaining about vehicles parked on pavements and causing an obstruction, especially to people using wheelchairs or pushing buggies. Advice from the RAC states "Parking on the pavement is not illegal outside of London." You can, however, still get a fine for doing so in some instances, which makes the law quite a grey area. Since 1974, Highway Code rule 244 has stated that drivers "MUST NOT park partially or wholly on the pavement in London and should not do so elsewhere unless signs permit it." The key things to note here are the words must not and should not. In London, you must not park on the pavement, the must indicating there is legislation behind this rule and you could receive a fine for breaking it. However, outside of the capital or "elsewhere", the Highway Code states drivers should not park on the pavement, meaning it is advisory and not, therefore, backed up by any legislation. Rule 242 is where it gets a little less clear, stating: "You MUST NOT leave your vehicle or trailer in a dangerous position or where it causes any unnecessary obstruction of the road." This is a must not, again, meaning if your car is reported or seen by a police officer and judged to be either in a dangerous position or causing an unnecessary obstruction of the road, you could receive a Fixed Penalty Notice. Residents concerned about parked cars causing an obstruction should take photos (including the number plate) and inform the police.

This month, we have had some brilliant careers talk from a whole range of visitors including a nurse, a vet, a theatrical director, an organisational psychologist, a maintenance fitter, an equality, diversity and inclusion leader and an area manager for a large supermarket chain. Our children asked some excellent questions and carried out some further research of their own. They certainly had their eyes opened to the opportunities that exist and had some great discussions about possible future career paths.

Year 5 and 6 had a wonderful cultural trip to Manchester, attending a classical concert by the Halle Orchestra at the Bridgewater Hall and visiting Manchester Art Gallery. Reception and Year 3/4 benefited from a very informative visit from Peter Nutsford who gave some brilliantly interactive talks about wildlife in Africa. Reception children were also thrilled to have some real life pets visit their classroom as part of their topic on animals. Class 2 loved their visit from the Mountain Rescue Team who shared a talk on the weather and its hazards, hill hazards, safety, preparing for outdoor adventures and what to do if things go wrong. There was great excitement in school when we were visited by the North West stages rally. The children had the chance to sit in the rally car, get buckled up and try on the driver's crash helmet, as well as sitting in the support ambulance.

The whole school took part in the NHS Yogi Mental Health Day when they learnt skills to improve mental wellbeing including: anxiety-relieving techniques, breathing techniques, yoga poses and mindful movement. The older children especially fed back how much they felt they had benefited from the session.

Our annual Caton's Got Talent competition on Red Nose Day was a huge success. We had twenty seven entries. Children from as young as four sang; danced; did gymnastics; played the piano, drums and guitar; did magic tricks; spoke and sang in foreign languages; and showed their knowledge of the flags of the world. It was a real celebration of all the talent in school. Congratulations to our Reception winner, Astrid; Key Stage 1 and overall winner, Finley; and our Key Stage 2 winner, Mackenna. Thank you to Steve Clarkson and Ruth Gibbons, our guest judges.

Music lessons have taken off in school recently. We have bought a drum set and now have five children learning to play the drums and others learning the violin and the guitar. Our school band is soon going to be an orchestra!!

#### CATON ST PAUL'S COF E PRIMARY

Another busy month at Caton St Paul's has seen lots happening across the school and pre-school. We held our annual Mothers' day breakfast where we had 120 mums and grandmas enjoying bacon and sausage sandwiches with their children. This was a vibrant and lovely morning where we celebrated with our community.

As the weather has improved (or not!!) we have started our outdoor education experiences for all children with a Year 2 trip to Warton Crag. They braved wind and rain to climb, scramble and hike up and around the crag, enjoying marshmallows on the way down. Our Year 1 children had a similar experience in Silverdale and thoroughly challenged and enjoyed themselves. At the end of March, our youngest children will have an adventure experience along the banks of the River Lune, with our Y3 children canoeing on the canal at Borwick. All of these trips use our local area and allow the children to flourish and grow in a supportive environment.

World book day was lovely, with children coming into school in their pyjamas and comfortable clothes (this takes the pressure off parents needing to make/buy an outfit).
