Echoes of the Lune Valley: A Photographic Journey By David Kenyon A Photographic History of the People and Places in and around a Lancashire Valley.

This new book by local historian David Kenyon contains fourteen chapters on the history of the Lune Valley. These include fascinating stories such as Claughton Hall being moved stone by stone to a new location by C M Slinger and Sons of High Bentham. Other topics include the discovery of an unexploded bomb during the Second World War and articles about local industry and farming. The book also features contributions from Michael Winstanley, who reflects on the restoration of St. James the Less church in Tatham by the Foster family; Susan Bull, who explores the rich history of Hornby Castle; and Colin Miller, who shares his recollections of farming and schooling in the 1940s. Complimenting the text are over one hundred quality photographs that really bring to life the people and places described. Echoes of the Lune Valley will be available in time for Christmas and can be purchased from Caton Village Institute. The book is priced at £15 and is sold in aid of St John's Hospice, Lancaster.

GROW CATON

The active growing season has finished, perennial plants have been cut back and mulch applied to the soil. We have harvested bean seeds, both for sowing in spring and for eating this winter. My new activity for these darker days is rescuing supermarket food from going to waste, through an organisation called Olio. This works entirely via the Olio App, where every night volunteers share food that has reached the 'Use By' or the 'Best By' date with their local community. I have a regular slot on Friday nights, which means that from 9pm onwards I will list on the App the food available for collection in Caton. Anyone can then request this for free via the App. The food will be mostly chilled, fruit & veg, and bakery items. The Olio App is very easy to use and navigate and has clear instructions all along the way with helpful messages to guide you. Do have a look at it and should you have any questions then do get in touch with Brigitte. Our Grow Caton group does keep on chatting via WhatsApp about harvests, fermenting, baking, composting and all things vegetable, to join us on WhatApp please email growcaton@outlook.com, for questions contact Brigitte 770771 or Anne 771470.

CATON PRIMARY SCHOOL

The closing date for primary school applications for entry in September 2025 is 15th January. Visits to the school are welcome. We offer an exciting curriculum, small class sizes, wraparound care, Forest School, some amazing residential trips, performing arts and sporting success. Call the school office on 01524 770104 to arrange an appointment.

Pupils are very much enjoying the topics they are learning about this term. Class 4's topic of peace and conflict was brought to life when they visited the Museum of Lancashire for an immersive WW2 experience. They got to see what it was like to be code crackers, spies, aerial surveillance analysts and D-Day strategists. In French, they have been learning to tell the time using the 24 hour clock and to describe their daily routine in French. They have shared presentations with their penpals in Socx and are very excited to see what comes back and to compare their daily lives with those of children in France! Class 3's local history topic, 'Where did all the mills go?' is a fascinating insight into Caton in the past - look out for the children on their historical walk around the village. Class 2 are learning about transport through time including the first flight and space travel. Continuing with the theme of travel, Reception Class has been busy enjoying cycling awareness sessions. They have learnt about the importance of wearing helmets and how to cross the road safely. We also had a visit from the Fire Brigade to teach the children about fire and road safety.

Sports teams have taken part in KS2 rugby and KS1 athletics competitions with KS1 children achieving some great individual successes. The children have been busy in the local community. The school's Eco Committee is up and running and children can be seen every week litter picking around Fell View playpark. On 11th November, our Key Stage 2 children attended the cenotaph in Caton village to take part in an act of remembrance and to lay a wreath. The PTA Bingo night was a great success; it was very well attended and raised funds for our Forest School project.
