PARISH COUNCIL

PRECEPT - The work of Caton-with-Littledale Parish Council is largely funded by the Parish Precept. Councillors have decided not to increase the Parish Precept for 2023/24.

HIGHWAYS LANCASHIRE HIGHWAYS - plans to start work end January 2023 on the scheme to make the A683 from J34 to Kirkby Lonsdale a 50mph speed limit. Still no date for when work will start on the black spot at the bend east of the Bull Beck carpark, but Highways are planning what to do.

QUERNMORE ROAD - At present this busy road has a 30mph limit and there are concerns about safety. The Parish Council is considering asking Highways to visit to see how it might be made safer, perhaps by making it a 20mph area.

FLOODING - Lancashire County Council is our Lead Local Flood Authority. They want to know if any homes or business premises in our area were affected by flooding in the January storms. If you had flood water inside please contact them on highways@lancashire.gov.uk.

OAK TREE AT THE FISH STONES - The sapling which has been there for a few years is unlikely to thrive, and the Parish Council is considering replacing it with another small tree also grown from an acorn from the old tree. Work may be done on the railings at the same time.

CATON GREENWAY PROJECT - Lancashire Environmental Fund has agreed funding towards the improvements proposed for the Greenway, including more trees and bushes. We hope it may be possible to get some planting done this year and will be looking for volunteers.

ELECTIONS - At the local council elections this May, there should be an election for parish councillors for Caton-with-Littledale. An election is only needed if there are more candidates than places - we have 12 seats. Your Parish Council needs more councillors and it would be great to have enough candidates to need an election. If you would like to know what being a councillor involves, you can see minutes and documents on the village website. Or speak to the Parish Clerk or a current councillor, or attend a Parish Council meeting this spring.

CATON ST PAUL'S C of E PRIMARY SCHOOL

Happy new year to all Link readers.

We have already been busy in school, even with 2023 only being a couple of weeks old. We welcomed 4 new children to our Pre-school and now have 21 registered.

In school, we enjoyed a Chinese New Year day, organised by the Confucius Institute at Lancaster University - all children learnt about Chinese traditions and how to speak Mandarin.

Our engaging curriculum continues with children studying many different periods of history across school this term:

In Diamond Class, our youngest children are learning about animals, starting with designing their own dinosaur.

Our Y1 Ruby children are learning about the local area and identifying local places of interest on a map, as well as finding out about the jobs local people do now and jobs that would have been done

In Y2, the children are studying Victorians and comparing their lives to what they already know about the Tudors.

Emerald class are diving into the Egyptians and will be comparing these events to what was happening in the rest of the world at that time.

Sapphire class are finding out about the Indus valley and what life was like for the people who lived there.

Our oldest children in Amethyst class are contrasting their knowledge of British history to the Maya people and comparing the two.

As well as the educational experiences our children receive, we also continue to offer a range of enrichment opportunities for all. Our Y5/6 athletics team competed at the recent County qualifier and finished a creditable 4th against many larger schools. This half-term, all KS2 children will take part in a river walk, identifying wildlife and trees and thinking about sustainability. We are also organising an art week at the start of February which will culminate in a fantastic exhibition for all to enjoy - keep your eyes peeled for more information.

Finally, our choir are singing at St Paul's Church on 5th Februaryto welcome the new vicar, Helen Scamman. We would like to extend a warm Caton St Paul's welcome to Helen and wish her well in her new role

CATON PRIMARY SCHOOL

We have started the new year with some very exciting learning. There was a huge kerfuffle in Reception when someone or something caused havoc overnight. 

B4RN HYPERFAST BROADBAND

If you're new to the village and aren't aware of B4RN Community fibre broadband then please check out b4rn.org.uk If you're in an existing long-term contract with another provider with less than 12 months to run, you'll be able to get B4RN for £5 a month until that contract runs out with B4RN's Connect+. Note that your Connect+ application MUST be approved before you go live as you can't apply retrospectively.

You can still get B4RN and government funding is available to help B4RN get the service to you. To get started with B4RN complete a service request at b4rn.org.uk/getb4rn

GROW CATON

We are a group of people who love to grow food and to encourage and enable others too. This group started in April 2022, we now have 10 people/families in our group, plus 6 villagers who are part of the garden share. We do not have a structure or meetings, we keep in touch with each other through a WhatsApp group chat, and pass on messages by other means to those who do not use this app. The activities we do are directed by the interest of those involved. We very much welcome new people who drive new ideas and will support almost anything that encourages others to grow food. Here follows a summary of what we do.

GARDEN SHARE: Brigitte matches available gardens (or garden space) with someone who wants to grow food, which usually means one grower matched per garden. Both owner and grower will agree the terms of this share and what they each hope to gain by sharing. The most basic gain is friendship and a share of the crops grown. We very much appreciate and respect that owners open their private space to us, and we do not allow photos to be taken, location details to be shared with others or money to change hands.

SURPLUS PRODUCE SHARE: During the main growing season, we encourage people to share their glut of produce with the local community, rather than throw it away. Anne has provided shelves at Beulah Lodge where surplus produce was left for others to pick up and use. This past season we have seen on the shelves: sweetcorn, courgette, beans, herbs, kale, apples, damsons, eggs, and many more items. For people who have fruit trees and bushes in their garden and are not able to pick these themselves, Anne will gladly come and pick to share with both owner and community.

TOOL LIBRARY: We kindly received some gardening tools, Dan and Margaret are now considering setting up a tool library.

COMMUNITY COMPOSTING: One of the suggestions at a recent village event was for community composting and we will be exploring this idea further. Our group can offer plenty of tips and advice for home composting.

COMMUNITY ORCHARD: the B4RN Caton Volunteer Group are providing funding for a community orchard and have obtained full approval by the Parish Council and Lancaster City Council who own the designated land. Grow Caton will work with the Gardening Club to draw up planting and maintenance plans. This is a great opportunity for villagers to get involved in very practical work. SEED SWAP: For the past 3 years Brigitte has provided a seed swap box in the village during the growing season. It is a place for anyone to drop off spare seeds from their used packets, to be picked up and used by others. The plan is that the box will be back at the library entrance of the Victoria Institute from February onwards.

SUPPORT, ENCOURAGEMENT, ADVICE: We would love to see everyone grow, even one vegetable in a pot. If you do not know where to start, then please get in touch and we will see how we can support you. Through our group chat we will aim to inspire each other by sharing our 'tasks for the week' and to try help each other with those bigger tasks where many hands make light work. We also share details of local events that are food and growing related.
