**History of Our Parish - Local History Deposit Box** There is interest in recording the history of our parish and building up an archive of documents and photographs to help create a fuller picture. The Parish Council has been trialling a modest system of a Local History Deposit Box at the Victoria Institute where residents can deposit documents, photographs or their own reminiscences about our parish. The Local History Deposit Box is now located within the library and contains some items already deposited for the reference of residents and anyone with an interest in our parish and its history. If you would be interested in getting involved in a local history group, please give your name to Peter Collins at the Victoria Institute.

Parking on double yellow lines at Station Road Vehicles often park on the double yellow lines at the junction of Station Road and the A683. This has been reported to Lancashire County Council as a problem area, and we may see more frequent visits by enforcement officers. To report parking on these double yellow lines, ring 0800 195 2774 or email parking@lancashire.gov.uk (ideally wth a photo showing the problem).

**Pedestrian bridge over Artlebeck on Brookhouse Road** The Parish Clerk is trying to get the leaves removed and the bridge surface made safe again.

**Ivy and vegetation on A683** The Parish Council is asking Lancashire County Council to trim back ivy and branches overhanging the A683 Lancaster Road in Caton.

**Greenway** The Parish Council is working with Lancashire County Council to get a number of improvements to the Greenway; users will have noticed the work already done to sweep and clean the path surface.

**Parish Precept** This is the part of your council tax which goes to your Parish Council. For 2025/26 it will increase by 5%. Our budget is on the PC website; in brief the main areas of expenditure are the Victoria Institute, clerk's wages, Play Park, village maintenance, grass cutting, village website and communications.

#### **GROW CATON**

The days are getting longer, which encourages plants to grow, and this month we will start sowing the first seeds. I will sow broad bean and onion which will germinate on the windowsill and are hardy enough to soon go to the greenhouse or cold frame for growing on. I am always tempted by sowing more veggies early, but it can mean that they will spend too long indoors if the weather stays cold, which makes weak plants. The seed swap box will come out again later this month at the small door of the Institute, behind the bus shelter. We will make sure there are a few seeds in the box to get started, please do take some to grow, and also drop off any spare seeds you may have. This year the surplus produce shelves will be back from the 1st of March at 75 Brookhouse Road. These can be used for swapping seedlings to start with. If you drop any plants off then please make sure to label them so we know what they are. The food rescue through Olio is going well with most of the food now being shared in the village. I am really hoping to keep this going through the summer and not let the growing get in the way. #### **CATON PRIMARY SCHOOL**

2025 has got off to a flying start at Caton Primary!

In the first week back, Class 3 continued with their local history learning, wrapping up warm and travelling back in time to discover what Caton Village was like in the 1840s. Led by an enthusiastic mill owner, the children walked to Low Mill, stopping at various points along the way to spot some of Caton's oldest buildings and discuss who would have lived there. They learnt about the importance of Artlebeck and what life might have been like for them as mill children. Reception Class had a very exciting first couple of weeks! The children found footprints all over their classroom and it seemed like someone had been in, left a mess, broken baby bear's chair and eaten all the porridge! The children investigated and had a number of theories as to how this could have happened and who did it. Class 4 put their computing skills into practice by creating some super websites focusing on sustainability and Class 2 have begun their learning about birds in English, with a trip to Martin Mere Wetland Centre planned for later in the term.

Developing responsible citizens of the future is very important to us. You may see some of our children out and about each week, litter picking around the village. Our Eco Committee meets weekly and is currently developing an eco action plan to make the school as environmentally friendly as possible. They began their campaign by conducting a thorough environmental assessment of the school. The Pupil Council also meets weekly and is focusing on promoting healthy lunches. We are proud of the academic standards that our children achieve and we are delighted to be included in the Lancaster Guardian's published list of the top 15 performing state primary schools in the Lancaster and Morecambe district. We are very fortunate to have such fantastic facilities and we make the most of these. Three professional sports coaches are working with the children this term in our wonderful sports hall, running lunchtime clubs, after-school clubs and curriculum lessons. A new club for this year is golf, run by the golf pro from Heysham Golf Club. Our forest is another enormous asset where Forest Schools learning takes place weekly.
