ROAD SAFETY - The Parish Council is still waiting for information from Lancashire Highways about the extension of the 30mph limit on the A683. We plan to install more Speed Indicator Devices in the village too.

LITTER AND WEEDS - A big thank you to Caton Baptist Church for organising a litter pick round the village in June. Apart from the Bull Beck Car Park and the roadside from the mini-roundabout towards Hornby, the amount of litter found was lot less than in previous years. However weeds in gutters and on pavements are a real nuisance, and growing fast in the current damp conditions. As well as looking unsightly, they can break up the surface on roads and pavements, and when they are in gutters can block drains and encourage flooding. The Parish Clerk has asked Lancaster City Council to deal with them. Until they do, local residents and businesses are asked to look after nearby pavements and gutters. Thank you!

SEATS IN BUS SHELTERS - We've been asked about providing seats within some of the bus shelters in the village. But what sort of seat? A flip-down perch? A small bench? OFF-ROAD BIKES

The police are receiving many reports relating to off-road bikes that have been causing a nuisance. The local police and local partner agencies are determined to tackle this problem in order to improve the quality of life and safety of local residents. If you have any issues with off road bikers in your local area you can report the issue via the non-emergency number 101 or via Crimestoppers anonymously on 0800 555 111. It would also be beneficial if you keep a record of the riders clothing, the type of off-road bike - quad bike, scrambler, mini-moto, a go-ped or something else and also the location and the name and address of the rider if this is known.
