HIGHWAY SAFETY AND IMPROVEMENTS - Lancashire County Council is making progress on planning the installation of average speed monitoring between Junction 34 and Kirkby Lonsdale. Part of this will include tackling the accident black spot near the Bull Beck car park.

FLOODING - Have you been affected by flooding over the last few years? From the river or a beck, from blocked drains or surface water run-off? A lot of different organizations may be involved in identifying the cause of the problems and finding the solution, including Lancashire Highways, United Utilities and the Environment Agency. Since it was set up in 2016, our local Community Emergency Group has sent in reports about local flooding to our Lead Local Flood Authority (Lancashire). The Lancashire Association of Local Councils is now working with the National Association of Local Councils to increase pressure on central government to tackle the problem more effectively. FOOTPATHS

1. Footpath alongside the Artlebeck from Brookhouse Road to Hornby Road

Lancashire County Council is responsible for reinstating this footpath. Both the Parish Council and the Peak and Northern Footpath Society have asked them to act. However the work will be very expensive. It seems it will need more pressure from local residents to get action from LCC on the footpath. If you want to see this footpath restored, please contact The Lancashire County Council Public Rights of Way team by email on PROW@lancashire.gov.uk, or telephone 01772 530317. The reference number for the footpath is FP14 in Caton-with-Littledale. It would be helpful if you could let the Parish Clerk have a copy of your letter or email, or information about your phonecall.

2. Potential lost rights of ways

The Ramblers Association has done a lot of work identifying potential lost rights of way throughout the country. They have used old maps and local volunteers to identify and map these paths. In our area there are a number around Escowbeck and running from Crook o' Lune/Scarthaite south into Quernmore. There are also possible lost paths in the hills in the Gresgarth/ Littledale/ The Cragg area. 3. Footpaths along country roads

Lancashire County Council and the Forest of Bowland AONB want to encourage safe rural walking routes. One improvement could be additional pavements on busy country roads, or new paths alongside them. In our parish this might include stretches such as from Forge Mill/Gresgarth into Caton or along Littledale Road. We'll keep you informed.

CATON ST PAULS C of E PRIMARY SCHOOL

Despite school being closed, we have continued to support our families while they are remote learning - we have managed to distribute 13 chromebooks and laptops to families that need them.

We held a mental health and wellbeing day where children took part in all manner of activities to try and have a day off screens: dancing, balloon balancing, and baking were just some of the activities families enjoyed. We also held a successful Corinthians day where children were encouraged to take part in activities based around the theme of Love is patient. We have broadcast live on Facebook every week from 4pm on a Friday in a bid to bring our community together.

Our eco-committee suggested the use of litter pickers for children to use on their daily walk - look out for children collecting rubbish around the village while they are taking exercise every day.

We are very proud of Georgia Till, one of our Y6 superstars who has donated 500 facemasks to St John's Hospice to raise money to support their wonderful work. These are on sale in Boots Lancaster or can be purchased from school for a suggested donation of £5.

We are considering the possibility of opening a pre-school on site for 3-4 year olds, to be run by the school. There was a pre-school on site for many years before the closure of Lune Valley pre-school last summer. To see if this is a viable option, we are conducting some market research to find out initial demand. THE EDWARD & ALICE COTTAM TRUSTS

The Trustees would like to make another distribution from the trust funds held on the trusts of the Wills of the Edward Cottam and his sister Alice.

The Trustees are required to use the trust income for the benefit of:

'poor and deserving persons aged 50 years or over who have resided within the parish of Caton with Littledale in the County of Lancaster for at least five years and are still resident at the date of the application'.

These charities are open all year round and the Trustees welcome applications for funds at any time from anyone who considers that they fulfil the above criteria (taken from the wording in the Wills of the late Edward and Alice Cottam) and also any organisations where the majority of its members fulfil the criteria.

The Trustees also make an appeal for applications once a year in order to distribute what income they can as well.

During the charities' last financial year (which ended 11th September 2020) the distributions to various individuals amounted to £8,150 and for organisations in Caton and Brookhouse amounted to £15,669.

This year, application forms will once again be available from the Brookhouse Post Office during the month of March and the postmaster has kindly agreed that completed forms can be left at the Post Office for us to collect. Alternatively, you can post them directly to Emma Edwards at BSG Solicitors LLP of 3 & 4 Aalborg Square, Lancaster LA1 1BJ telephone: 01524 386500. All applications will be welcomed and treated with strict confidentiality.

It is hoped that the distributions of trust money will be made before the end of June.

LATEST B4RN NEWS

The current government voucher scheme which helps fund the expansion of B4RN in the village is ending soon. It is VITAL that anyone who would like a connection to hyper fast, full fibre, Gigabit broadband applies for a voucher today.

Once applied for B4RN have 12 months to redeem these vouchers. This government money will fund the hard dig of fibre connections into our villages.

Search "GETB4RN" in a browser, fill in your postcode on the page that comes up, and fill in the subsequent form. For more information see the B4RN entry below

CATON NEWS - The plan to install B4RN fibre broadband into Caton, through the pavements, is nearly complete. A "toby" box will be dropped in the pavement at the boundary of each property. Various options are available for you to then get it into your property. B4RN service costs £30/month (unlimited 1Gb upload and download) and there is a one off £150 connection fee. However, if done through the government voucher scheme, a £150 payment is made back to you when the service goes live. The contract stipulates taking a 12-month service but B4RN charge NO leaving fees, so it is, essentially, a monthly rolling contract.

The government voucher scheme that enables projects like this to happen ends soon. It is vitally important that, if you have not done so already, you go to the "GETB4RN" page and apply for the voucher before 12th March. B4RN then have 12 months to redeem that voucher (meaning they need to install the network in the village before March 2022)

BROOKHOUSE NEWS - We already have fibre in the ground in parts of Brookhouse. The government voucher scheme enables us to expand the network and get to hard to reach areas via the pavement. This scheme ends in March so if you are remotely interested in getting a B4RN connection register now at b4rn.org.uk/getb4rn – this could be the last chance for us to obtain this funding.

Extracts from 'The story of Methodism in Caton' Written by H W Baker in 1936

The first authentic record of the village by its present name is found in Domesday Book compiled in 1086, twenty years after the Norman Conquest, in which Caton appears as one of twelve manors granted to Torfin, one of the Conqueror's barons. From the etymology of the word we may reasonably infer that a Saxon hamlet was already in existence bearing this name. In the reign of King John the manor had become the property of the Gernets, the ancient foresters of Lancaster, and in the time of Elizabeth it belonged to Thomas Stanley, Lord Monteagle of Hornby Caton. In 1539 the Baines family occupied Caton Hall the seat of the manor. This house was situated above Hall Dub below the old highway of Caton Green. The manor was purchased by William Croft of Claughton in 1597 and, in 1688, it was held by Robert Dalton of Thurham, being sold by one of his descendants to Henry Rawlinson in 1780. The Rawlinsons sold it to Thomas Edmondson in 1806, and it is now the property of his great grandson Col. P.T Denis De Vitre.
