Fell View Play Park Three new bench and table sets have been installed. They are made out of recycled plastic, so should last well. Expertly installed by Chris Lennon. Our thanks go to the local volunteer group of B4RN who helped fund the purchase, to the Duchy of Lancaster Benevolent Fund for their donation towards the Play Park, to Caton Gala for their donation and to the Lancashire Environmental Fund for its grant towards this whole project.

Closure of Brookhouse Road at Artlebeck Bridge The Parish Council still has no firm information from Cadent or from Lancashire Highways on when this will happen, or the alternative travel arrangements. Cadent are aware that residents are very unhappy about the state of Beckside after they used it for their compound, and we expect it to be landscaped after the bridge work is finished.

Grass cutting This season, Lancaster City Council are to cut grass verges 7 times between April and October, and will cut Fell View Play Park and Playing Field 14 times in that period. We hope that this will make Fell View more attractive and usable throughout the summer.

Footpaths We are aware that some useful shortcuts - ginnels or snickets - are difficult to access if you are using a mobility scooter or pushing a pram or buggy. We are asking Lancashire County Council to look at how access can be improved.

Carpark on Hornby Road At last the white lines have been repainted!

Annual Parish Meeting This is a meeting where the Parish Council reports on its work over the previous year and presents its accounts. It's also an opportunity for residents to raise any issues of local concern. This year it will be held on Tuesday 14th May at 6.30pm at the Lune Valley Methodist Hub in Brookhouse. The Parish Council will also have a stand at Caton Gala, and you are invited to come and chat to councillors there.

CATON ST PAUL'S C OF E PRIMARY

The lead up to Easter in a Church school is always special and this year was no different as we welcomed our school community to watch our Easter service at St Paul's Church on Maundy Thursday. We were also thrilled to hear our choir sing so beautifully and fill the Church with their wonderful voices.

We had about 150 children in the hall, ranging from ages 4-11, playing to win Easter eggs and the star prize hamper. The evening was great fun and it was lovely to see our Y6 children sitting with our youngest children and helping them with their numbers. We wrapped up our indoor athletics season by competing in the final round of fixtures in both the Y3/4 and Y5/6 tournaments. This is a phenomenal achievement for a school of our size as we regularly compete against the larger schools in Lancaster and Morecambe. Our commitment to providing sporting opportunities to all our children continued in March with children competing in a range of sports including swimming, korfball, hockey and football – some even on the same night.

Our Y5 children were given the chance to ensure they are safe on their cycles as they completed their bikeability training. This involved practising on the playground, as well as riding and performing manoeuvres on the road. Look out for our children as they safely navigate their way around the village on their bikes, with their helmets on!

As part of our drive to be greener and healthier, we also took part in the Big walk and wheel, an initiative which encourages children and adults to walk, bike or scoot to school. Over the two weeks, 60% of our journeys to school were walking, cycling or scooting, putting us 41st in the North West!
