Next Parish Council Meeting Tuesday 9th October, 7pm, Victoria Institute

Road safety Road safety is a major issue for many residents, and the Parish Council wants to take our proposals to Lancashire County Council. Our ideas so far are:

- the creation of a "20 mph zone" throughout Caton and Brookhouse;
- pedestrian crossings, speed limits and further traffic calming beyond Caton on Lancaster Road, Hornby Road and Quernmore Road;
- a 30 mph speed limit in Caton Green and onwards to Brookhouse;
- improvements to and around the mini-roundabout at the centre of Caton;
- · making Holme Lane a No Through Road;
- a full review of the provision and quality of pavements throughout the built-up areas;
- consideration of making pavement parking illegal on some streets



Our first community event is harvest festival on Monday 7 October at 9:30am in St Paul's Church. Each class will deliver an input and there will be school's artwork displayed in the Church. We have again signed up to the Lune Valley sports partnership, as well as Lancaster and Heysham. This gives all our children the chance to represent the school at sporting events. Our outdoor ed calendar is set with Y6 starting us off caving in Long Churn in October and Y4 visiting Barbon to clamber up a dry river bed. The choir are meeting and preparing to go to perform at the singing festival at the Town Hall in March. Our extra-curricular clubs are up and running with 17 on the timetable; art clubs, drama clubs, sports clubs, music clubs, eco clubs, computing clubs and wellbeing clubs seem to be the most popular.
