Email: clerk@catonparishcouncil.gov.uk Evening buses Following pressure from your local councillors and the Lancaster Bus Users Group, an evening bus service between Lancaster and Hornby starts on 2 Sep. Mon to Sat, no service Sun or Bank Holidays. Full timetables will be available from the Victoria Institute. The additional buses will leave Lancaster bus station at 1952, 2052, 2152 and 2252 returning from Hornby, Swimming Pool at 2022, 2122 and 2222. Let's make sure these buses are well-used!

Hedges Residents and landowners are required to cut hedges and bushes back so they do not obstruct roads and pavements. This is so that pedestrians can walk safely along a pavement without dodging branches and brambles, and drivers can see well at corners and junctions. The Parish Clerk is writing to premises which are causing a problem. If there is no action, Lancashire County Council may get involved, and they have the right to carry out essential work and charge the property owner. Please inform the Parish Clerk of any overgrown hedges or bushes obstructing roads and pavements in our parish.

Road safety The Parish Council is working on a list of the main road safety concerns in our parish, intending to present them to Lancashire County Council as a package for road improvements and speed limits. We are assured that the accident black spot at Bull Beck will be addressed this financial year

Fell View Play Park It is hoped that the autumn will see work to remove the rotten timbers and replace them with a grassed slope and fence.

Greenway A surfaced path will be laid to improve access to the new picnic table at the bridge over the Artle Beck. Further work is planned in coming months to repair or replace gates, repair walls and cut hedges.

#### COLLECT YOUR FRESH, LOCAL AND SEASONAL FOOD FROM LUNE VALLEY METHODIST HUB

Have you heard about Gather? It's the brand-new North Lancs Food Hub - so called because it brings together local, seasonal food in one place online, and then distributes direct to the doorstep or convenient pick up points in the community - and one of them is the Lune Valley Methodist Hub in Brookhouse. Currently there are ten fantastic local producers and growers selling their delicious wares from organic fruit and veg, to pasture-fed cuts of beef, raw milk from a cow with calf dairy, traditional sourdough bread, pure honey from the Lune Valley as well as relishes and jams. All the suppliers on the hub are fully signed up to the Good Food Manifesto, which means they produce and grow 'low-mileage' food in a way that is good for people, place and planet. The hub is a pilot set up with a UK Government grant from the Shared Prosperity Fund, coordinated by LESS CIC in partnership with eggcup and aims to help create a thriving local food system connecting local, small-scale producers with new customers. The shop opens weekly from 2pm on Fridays until 10am on Tuesdays with deliveries the following Friday. To find out more, visit gatherhub.uk


